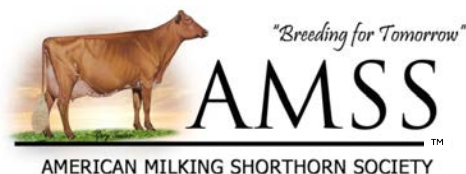

# PRESIDENT'S CORNER

In many organizations, it is easy to become obsessed with the ultimate mission—the “North Star” goals that define long-term vision. We keep our eyes fixed on the horizon, measuring our success by how much distance remains. However, when the road is long and the challenges are complex, that distance can feel daunting. It is in these seasons of hard work that the wisdom of legendary coach Lou Holtz provides important perspective.

Holtz, known for building championship cultures at Notre Dame and beyond, often reminded his teams:

*“We aren’t where we want to be, and we aren’t where we’re going to be, but thank God we aren’t where we used to be.”*

Success is rarely the result of one breakthrough or big win. Instead, it is the result of continuous improvement and the commitment of every member to be slightly more efficient, more collaborative, and more disciplined today than we were yesterday. When we improve by just a small amount, gains compound, creating a powerful momentum.

It’s important to recognize the work we have accomplished, acknowledge the systems we’ve fixed, the hurdles we’ve cleared, and the growth we’ve sustained. If we are even one step ahead of where we stood last year, or two years ago, we have proven that our collective strategy is working.

Holtz coached his teams to live by the acronym W.I.N.—What’s Important Now? He knew that an organization cannot win next year’s battles today. We can only win at the current project, the current meeting, or the current challenge.

As we continue to push toward our larger goals, let us not let our “ideal future” become the enemy of our “improved present.” Celebrate the fact that we have outgrown our past limitations. The mountain ahead is still tall, but the view from where we stand today is significantly better than it was when we began.

Let’s keep climbing.

## **We Don't Need to Be the Loudest Breed—Just the Right One**

Spring has a way of clearing things out. It opens barn doors, greens up pastures, and gives us space to think about what truly works. From where I sit—listening to breeders, juniors, and dairy families across the country, one thing feels especially clear right now.

Milking Shorthorns don't need to be the loudest breed in the room. We just need to be the right one.

In an industry often driven by extremes, Milking Shorthorns have always taken a different path. Ours is a breed built on balance. On cows that last. On people who care deeply about what they're building and who comes after them.

The diversity of this breed is what makes it unique—and what makes it work.

I hear it repeatedly in conversations this time of year. From breeders who are tightening budgets and keeping cows that earn their keep. From families who want cattle their kids can grow up with. And I see it in juniors discovering that success doesn't come from chasing one look or one number, but from understanding what works in their own barn. These aren't flashy stories—but they're the ones that endure.

Milking Shorthorns fit where real life happens. Our diversity shows up in many forms—color patterns, pedigrees, production goals, management styles—but it all points to the same purpose: cattle that function in real life.

That kind of diversity doesn't always demand attention. It doesn't create noise. But it creates staying power.

Being “the right breed” means showing up quietly and doing the job well. It means cows that calve again. It means udders that hold up. Feet and legs that travel pasture. Temperaments that make chores smoother and shows more enjoyable. It means acknowledging that there isn't one perfect model for dairying—and building a breed that respects that reality.

It also means people.

One of the greatest strengths of this breed has always been its community. The breeders who pick up the phone. The juniors who help one another in the showing. The families who come back year after year—not because it's easy, but because it's worth it. That kind of commitment can't be manufactured. It grows slowly, like spring grass, rooted in consistency and care.

As we move into another season, my hope is that we continue to embrace who we are. We do not need to shout to be relevant. What we need is to keep telling honest stories, raising functional cattle, and welcoming the next generation into a breed that has room for them. Our strength lies in our willingness to let the breed work where it's needed most.

Milking Shorthorns have never been about noise.

They've always been about balance, purpose, and versatility.

And that's more than enough.

# BOARD MOTIONS

---

## NOVEMBER 2025

- AMSS will allow ringside pictures from Dairy Agenda Today or Cowsmopolitan to be used for the All-American contest, only for animals whose photographs were reported lost by Cybil Fisher for the 2025 contest.
- \$15,000 will be moved from investments to checking account to pay the remaining 2025 bills.

## DECEMBER 2025

- Effective 1/1/26, vouchers will be provided in place of physical awards for national convention awards.
- Effective 2/1/26, the owners that put semen in the AMSS tank will be charged \$1.00/ unit, 15% will be charged when semen is sold. If semen is not sold within 12 months, \$1.00/ unit will be charged.
- Purchase a new semen tank for no more than \$1,700.00.
- Effective 7/1/26, DNA or Genomic testing must be completed for ALL ET calves before registration papers are returned to owner. This will eliminate the need for embryo/ recovery paperwork to be sent to the office.
  1. Breeder provides sample when sending in registration application OR
  2. Breeder provides results when sending in registration application.
- Effective 1/1/26, all board members must be in-person for summer and winter board meetings.
- Any semen the Executive Secretary delivers, the purchase will include shipping cost, delivery fee of \$25.00 and standard mileage rate.
- There will be no pass through at the 2026 National Sale.
- Approval of all committee reports.
- Revised wording: National Shows: All person(s) or entities printed on the registration paper must be a member in good standing with AMSS to show at a national show. When the owner is a person of an entity, both the person and entity must be a member.

## 2026 ANNUAL MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT

To the members of the American Milking Shorthorn Society:

Please let this notice serve as invitation to the 2026 annual meeting of the American Milking Shorthorn Society to be held Friday, June 26, 2026, at 9:00 am EST. The meeting will take place at Greek Peak Mountain Resort, Cortland, NY.

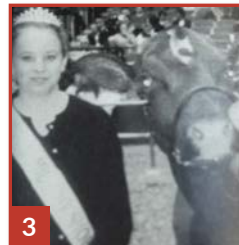

# WHITE'S MILKING SHORTHORNS- MARATHON, NY

**I**t was in the 1940's when it happened!

My Father, J. Marlin White, was a cattle dealer who owned and operated White's Market, in Marathon, New York. He was also the Town Supervisor, Father of seven and a farmer. A Marathon lady, Mrs. Ella Atkinson, owned the only herd of Milking Shorthorn cattle in the county. On occasion, my Father would handle sales and purchases, for her, mostly on the railroad. It was his interactions with Milking Shorthorns, that attracted him to them. He liked their temperament; they were dual purpose and when slaughtered there was less waste.

The first purebreds were purchased at a sale in Greenfield, Massachusetts. The cattle came from: Seyon Farm (Charlie Noyes-State of Maine), Anderson Herd (Steve Dole-Massachusetts), Patten Hill (Francis Barnard-Massachusetts) and the University of New Hampshire (Cy Terrill).

J.M. & H.M. White first exhibited at the New York State Fair in Syracuse- 1952. ( Brother, Harold, known locally as "Shorthorn" or "Horns" is the H.M.) Dad and Harold, the whole family too, learned a lot from that experience. But, they got the "bug" !

Friendships with Allen Drake of Last Chance Ranch - Lake Placid, NY and Frank Dale of Mystery Farms - Hope, Rhode Island encouraged entries to the All-American in Harrisburg, Pa, Eastern States Exposition in Springfield, Massachusetts, World Dairy Expo in Madison, Wisconsin and once Harold got on a railroad car in Springfield with our cattle, going all the way to Waterloo, Iowa.

In 1981, while in the showring at the Big E in Springfield, Massachusetts J. Marlin suffered a fatal heart attack. The those following years the name changed to White's Milking Shorthorns. For over 60 years total, the White Family has entered their Milking Shorthorns in various shows.

Although showing cattle is in the past, the love of the breed and the promotion of them is something the White Family is committed to do.

Now Harold has a cow/calf operation and fuses with his bulls, who learn to kiss and even let him ride them in a parade or bring them downtown for a walk.

Harold and his wife Lolita, she is a retired Art Teacher, are now in their eighties, they are active in their community and Milking

Shorthorn circles. He has served as President of the New York State Milking Shorthorn Association (many different times), President of the New England Milking Shorthorn Association, a delegate to the New York State Purebred Dairy Cattle Association, has served on the AMSS Endowment Fund, has been a New York delegate to the annual AMSS meeting many times. In fact, readers may recall visiting White's Milking Shorthorns, (Marathon, New York) in 2001, when the New England Association hosted the Annual AMSS Meeting in Cortland County, state of New York. That year's theme was "Where it all Began".

In Marathon, Harold and Lolita are both active with the Masonic Lodge (Masons & Eastern Stars) and the Marathon Area Historical Society. Harold is a member of the Marathon Lions. He is a Republican Committeeman and former Fire Commissioner.

Harold is pretty famous for being a positive supporter of Milking Shorthorns and is well known for encouraging young people to take an active part in the breed. He is generous with his time promoting and teaching 4-Hrs. He is first to reach in his pocket to lend financial support. Harold is always willing to give an interested youngster lots of encouragement.

It was Ellie Fleming, one of those former youngsters influenced by Harold, who nominated him to receive the AMSS Citizen of the Year, in 2020. In her written nomination she wrote "Harold White's core belief is to try to make things better, where ever you are in your life. He is a positive in a world of negativity. It is his spirit, his dedication to our breed and his desire to "make things better" that I salute him."

Lending a helping hand on the farm - which is 100% Milking Shorthorns (may be the only farm in NY State with "only" that breed on the farm) is nephews: Curtis, who lives next to the farm; and Jefferson is the New York State Milking Shorthorn Association's treasurer.

Harold and Lolita and their family invite you to a New York Style Supper/Dinner at the White Farm on June 24th. It will be the kick off for the 2026 National Milking Shorthorn Convention. # PEDIGREES, SHOW AND SALE RESULTS, DHIA REPORTS, AaA AND PROOFS...

All tools we use to make decisions. Percentages on our pedigrees are another tool that can help to make breeding decisions in our herds.

Around 1950, the breed met a fork in the road. Some breeders with Shorthorns wanted to continue with the substantial cow that could feed a calf and put a good amount of meat on her. Others wanted to focus on the breed as a dairy cow, looking to increase milk production, clean up her frame, and compete in the show ring with the other dairy breeds.

To make the traditional Milking Shorthorn more competitive in the show ring, some breeders crossed their Milking Shorthorns with Holsteins or other international red breeds. This brought forth the EXP system of showing breed purity. Originally, it was easy to calculate purity...if one parent was a Milking Shorthorn (and could trace back to generations of Milking Shorthorns on the top and bottom of the pedigree) and the other a Holstein, the offspring was a 50:50 (GE). Take that 50:50 and cross it with a Milking Shorthorn, that gave you an EXP (75%). (To really dig into this system, check out the policy section at the bottom of the AMSS website home page.)

However, generations and generations and crosses and crosses performed has made it difficult to follow the actual purity of cattle. We were so used to EXP = 75% Milking Shorthorn, GE = 50% and Full = 100%, that some breeders who tried to market bulls internationally were surprised that, when after deeper calculations were done on purity, cattle didn't always match the 50, 75, or 100%.

After rounds of talks, the "AMSS Percentages Calculations Protocol" was approved by the AMSS Board of Directors in 2022. The percentage committee started by doing full pedigree searches to determine values for over 700 bulls. Hundreds of hours were spent tracing multiple generations behind those bulls to get to the most primary values to begin with and then build from there to get the most accurate percentage.

Verified values were entered into ABRI. There are currently over 2,500 values (male and female) that are used to compare to the ABRI values that are calculated.

While we were able to model our ABRI system after other breeds, we all know that Milking Shorthorns are unique. It has taken rounds and rounds of communications with programmers

to get all our nuances of naming and ownership options and percentages to get it to a system that breeders can use with ease.

Most breeders might not realize the calculated percentages on the pedigrees. The actual percentages there are a tool and do not have any bearing in the show ring. They are merely meant as an option for breeders to utilize when making mating decisions, much like looking at pedigrees, show and sale results, DHIA reports, etc. The great thing about raising dairy cattle is that the breeder can choose what tools they want to use and what works best in their herd.

If you do some investigating into the percentages on your pedigrees and feel that there is a discrepancy in a calculated percentage in a pedigree, contact Kate with specific details. She will send it to the committee to recalculate and they will dig deeper to make sure that the percentage calculated is accurate. Percentage edits are quick fixes in ABRI and the system will automatically transfer those percentages to all progeny.

# BEV'S BAKED BEANS

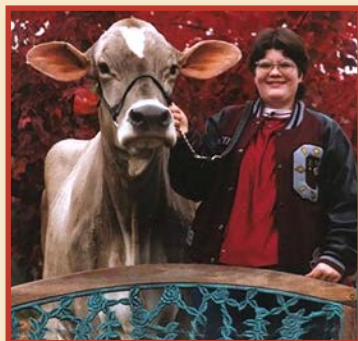
from the kitchen of Bev Wicks, Enumclaw, WA  
(published in the "Good Eating for Milking Shorthorn Friends" - 1979 Iowa National Meeting)

8 slices bacon  
2 med. onions  
2 cans pork and beans (with sauce)  
2 cans red kidney beans (drained)  
2 cans lima beans (drained)  
Parmesan cheese

2 cans butter beans (drained)  
½ cup cheddar cheese (cubed)  
1 cup brown sugar  
2/3 cup ketchup  
4 Tbsp. Worcestershire sauce

Sauté bacon and onions until brown. Combine with rest of ingredients. Place in a large, shallow baking dish and sprinkle with Parmesan cheese. Bake for 30 min. at 350°.

NOTE: This is a perfect casserole for picnics, potlucks or buffets.

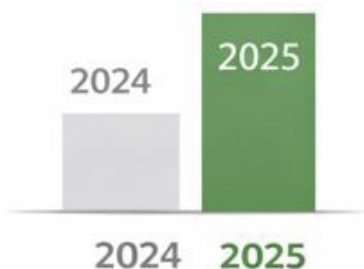

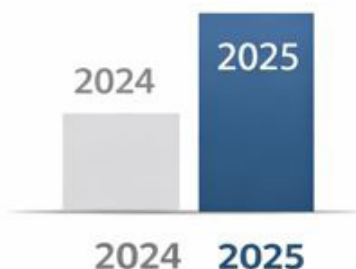

**What is your biggest accomplishment with Milking Shorthorns?**

Having back to back Junior Best 3 nominations and having our first home bred heifer nomination.

**What are your goals for the future?** Keep developing our genetics as best as we can and hopefully share them with other Milking Shorthorn breeders so they can enjoy them as much as we have.

**What is your favorite Milking Shorthorn cow or bull of all time?**

Kuzmar Arkansas Mud is a cow that comes to mind. The first time I saw her at Kuszlyk's I was in awe. A true powerhouse cow that stood out from the rest.

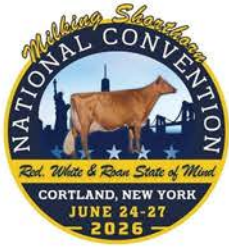

# IN MEMORIAM



## EMILY BROOKS ROWE 1931 - 2026

Emily Brooks Rowe passed away peacefully in Vacaville, CA on January 24, 2026. Emily was born in Sacramento on November 17, 1931 to Frederick and

Margaret Brooks of Davis, CA.

Emily graduated from UC Davis in 1953. She was a strong advocate of education, not only for her six children but for the entire community. She served on school boards in Graton (Sonoma County) as well as in Dixon (Solano County). Other community activities included service on the Dixon Library Commission and longtime membership in the Tremont Mite Society. She was proud to have played a major role in getting the Tremont Church restored and listed on the California State Register of Historic Places.

Emily was fascinated by old houses and home restoration, antiques and collectibles, and also traveled widely. Notable trips included driving with children to Alaska in 1974 and Maine in 1978, and dairy-related trips to Australia and South Africa with Stuart. These and other interests notwithstanding, her lifelong passion revolved around animals and farming. During Emily's first marriage (to Robert Lynde from 1951 to 1979), family life included a hobby farm.

After moving from Graton to Dixon with her two youngest children in 1979, Emily married childhood friend Stuart Rowe in 1981. Her farming activities took on greater depth through involvement with his family's Innisfail Dairy. Recordkeeping, registering cattle, attending fairs and shows, and dealing with the myriad aspects of a full-time dairy business in partnership with Stuart filled many happy days. Stuart's leadership of the American Milking Shorthorn Society led them to spend 1997-2001 in Beloit, WI, at the Society's headquarters. Emily and Stuart also farmed in Orland, CA, from 2007-13, and then retired to their home at the Rowe family farmstead at Tremont in the Dixon area. In recent years, Emily enjoyed the continued presence of a few young cows and a pair of oxen at Tremont.

In Dixon, Emily was a member of Dixon United Methodist Church. She also felt a sense of belonging with Davis Friends Meeting, where she maintained friendships in connection with her mother Margaret, who had been a founding member of the Meeting many years prior. Emily was very fortunate to have had her mother close by for daily afternoon tea for most of her time in Graton as well as for many years after her return to the Davis area.

Emily is survived by her husband Stuart; children John (Theresa) of AZ, Dan (Robin) of CA, Sally (John) of CO, Molly (Michael) of MI, Rob (Renée) of CO, and Paul (Jill) of CA; also survived by stepchildren John, Courtney (Craig), Laura, and Erin (David), all of CA; and the combined families' many children and grandchildren.

# IN MEMORIAM



## DALE JAMES FLETCHER

1963 - 2026

Dale James Fletcher was born on April 6, 1963, in Castro Valley, California, to Tom and Loretta Fletcher. He was the fourth of seven children and grew up on the family farm in Hayward, a place that shaped the man he would become and held a lifetime of fond memories.

In 1974, the Fletcher family moved to Dixon, California. Dale often reminisced about those early days, hauling wheelbarrow loads of brick and cement, planting trees, and sleeping in the shade of a camp trailer to cool off. The family moved the summer between Dale's fifth and sixth grade, and he quickly found his place in Dixon, especially through 4-H in Solano County.

Throughout the 1980s, Dale continued working on the family farm and running his custom hay business, building lifelong relationships across Solano County and beyond. He never hesitated to lend a hand, whether fixing something, helping with a project, or showing up when someone needed him.

It was at a 4-H event in sixth grade, that Dale met the love of his life, Kelly Hansen. From that moment on, they were inseparable. Dale and Kelly were married on December 27, 1986. In 1989, they welcomed their daughter Amanda, followed by their son Matthew in 1991. Dale was a hands-on, devoted father with a special gift for babies. His kids grew up tagging along everywhere, napping in the harrow bed, riding in the truck to deliver hay, and learning by doing. Animals were always part of their lives, and so were lessons in responsibility, independence, and kindness.

In the early 1990s, Dale pursued his love of farming and in 2000, following in the footsteps of his father and grandfather, Dale became a Millwright. Over the years, he worked on countless projects, including the Budweiser plant, Lawrence Livermore Lab, Sacramento International Airport, and ultimately the Chevron refinery in Richmond.

Dale retired from Millwrights Local 102 in August of 2025. Among his Millwright family, he was known for taking new workers, with integrity and work ethics, under his wing and patiently teaching them everything he knew.

Dale was a true jack-of-all-trades. He could fix just about anything, especially if baling twine was involved. He never met a stranger and was always ready with a story, often beginning with his signature phrase, "My favorite one was...", a sure sign it was time to settle in for a good tale. He was the ultimate baby whisperer, instinctively drawn to infants and able to calm them almost instantly.

Dale and Kelly's love story began at age 12 and lasted a lifetime, through 4-H events, fairs, square dancing, prom, and countless shared projects. Dale would do anything Kelly asked, maybe not always on time, but always with love.

Dale lived a life rooted in hard work, generosity, humor, and love, for his family, his animals, his community, and the land. Due to an unfortunate farming accident, he went with his boots on, and he will be deeply missed.

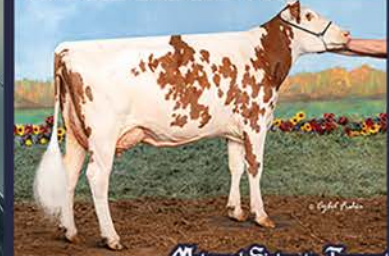

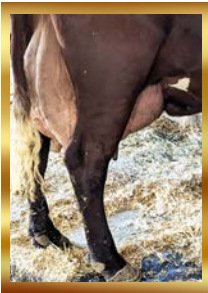
