1. Applicants must be a member of the American Milking Shorthorn Junior Society at the time of application.

3. Applicants majoring in agriculture degrees are given highest consideration.
4. Non-Agricultural majors that plan to contribute to agriculture through the AMSS or AMSJS for example will also be given consideration
5. Applicant must submit a letter of acceptance to a four-year, one or two-year technical, or short course.
6. College Student applicants (four-year, one or two-year technical, or short course) must include a Current Class Schedule.
7. Applicants DO NOT need to be present at the Annual National Milking Shorthorn Convention to be awarded. (Application is judged based on application-No interview)
